For this trip, we are going to an island off the north coast of Venezuela where we will spend our days (six of them) fishing for bonefish, tarpon, jacks, permit, barracuda... wading on the flats or from small motor boats. The resort has a very limited capacity which means light fishing pressure and tons of elbow room. Each pair of anglers will have their own bilingual guide (fluent in English and “fish”).

I am a board-certified veterinary dentist who also likes to fly fish and I will be providing the veterinary dental continuing education component of this trip.



I will present a two-hour lecture for five evenings following a sumptuous dinner. I am very open to tailoring the topics to the needs and expectations of the other travellers but for now I envision spending time discussing radiology, dental and oral anatomy, periodontal disease, homecare products and strategies and pro-active veterinary dentistry.
